



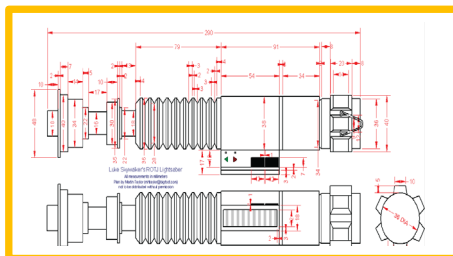
Intro to Machine Shop with Blueprint Reading
